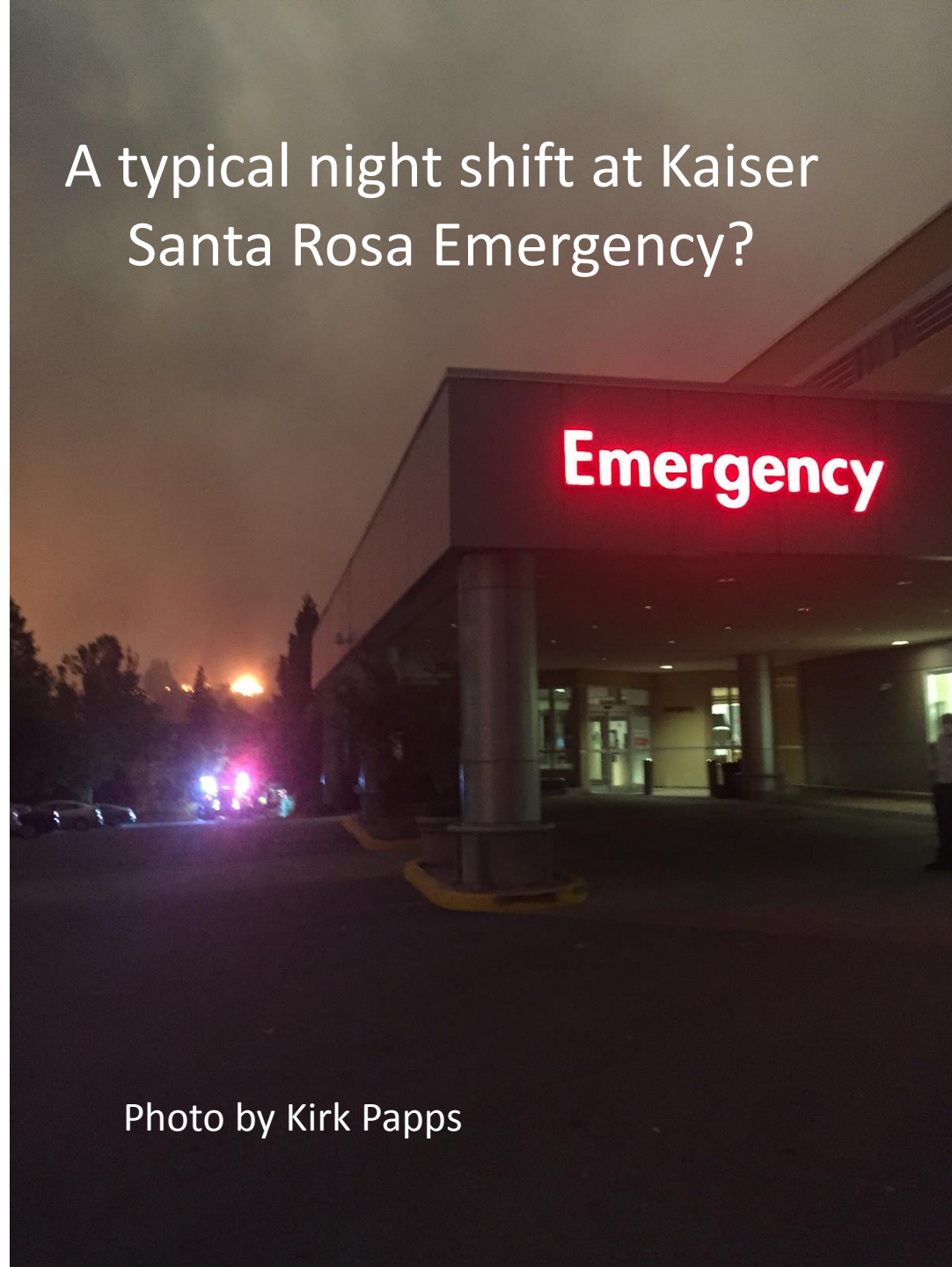

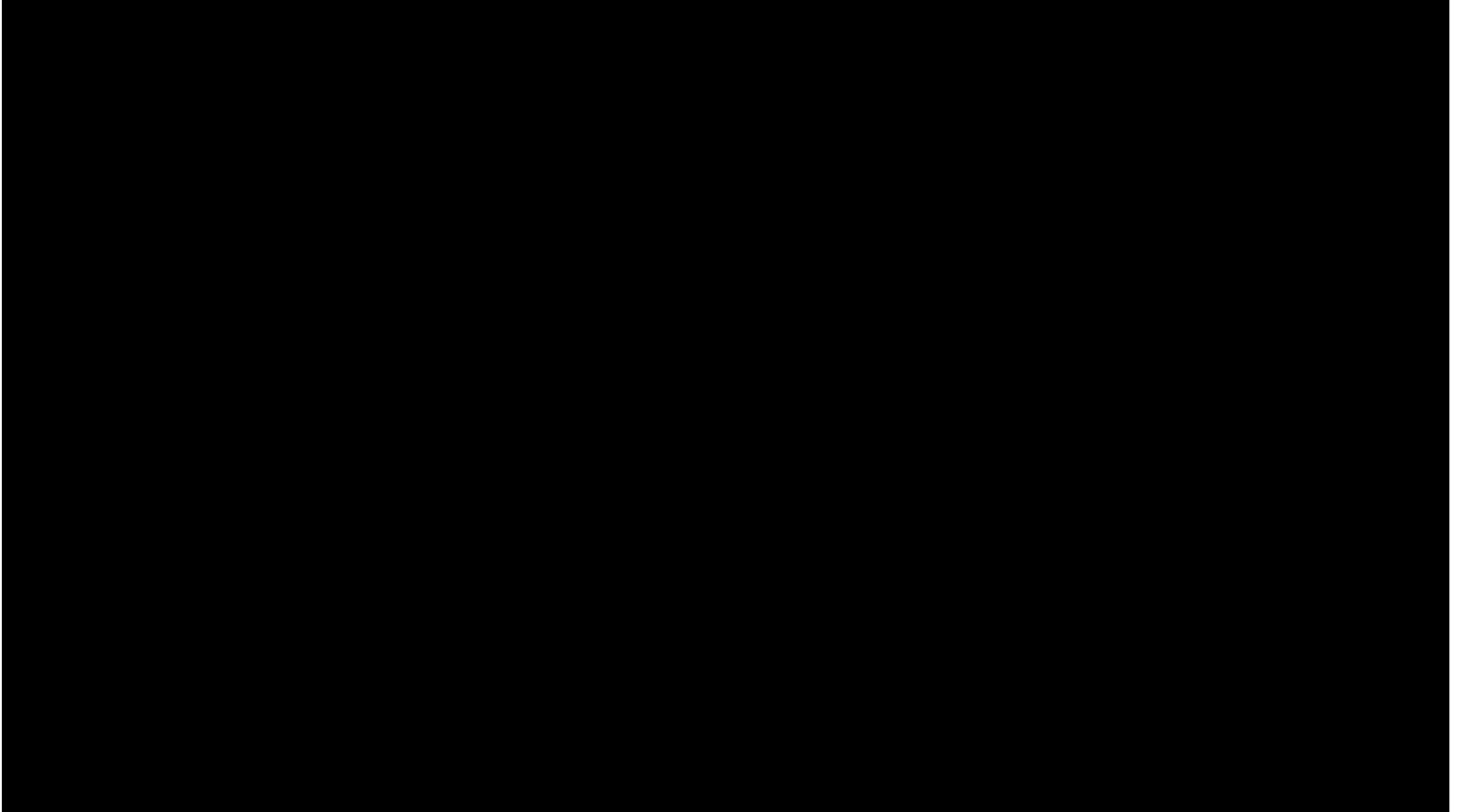

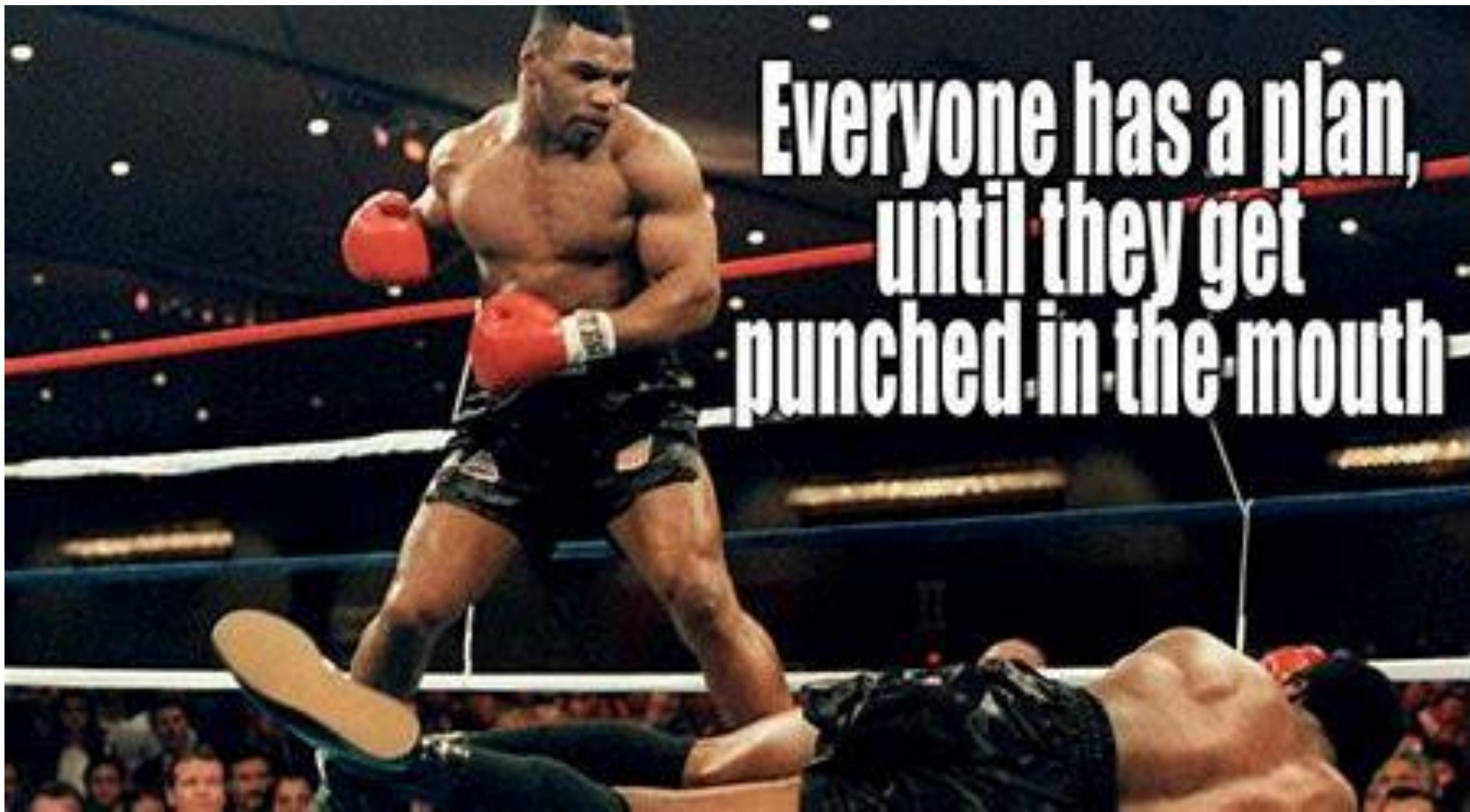

- Special needs

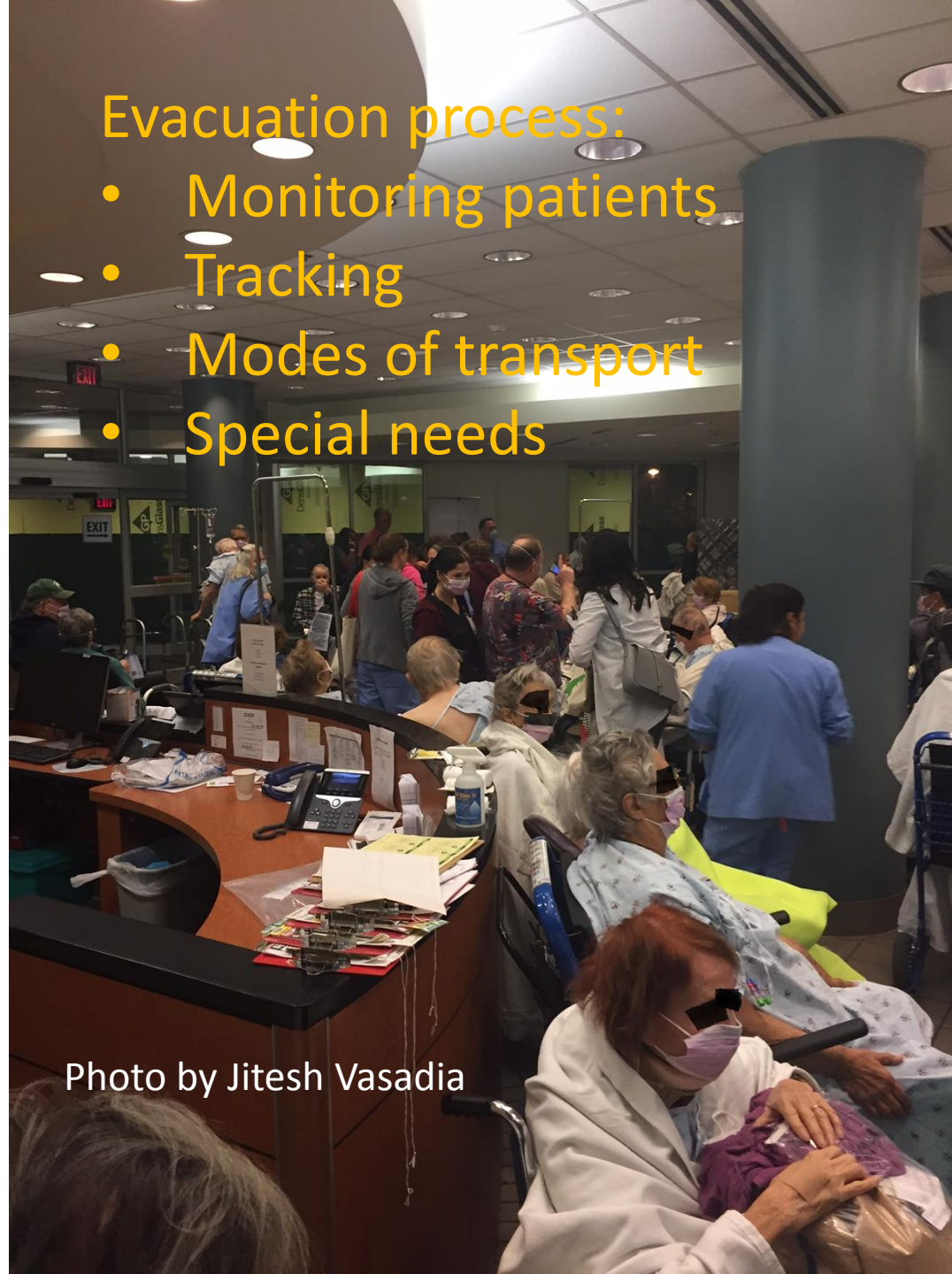


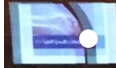

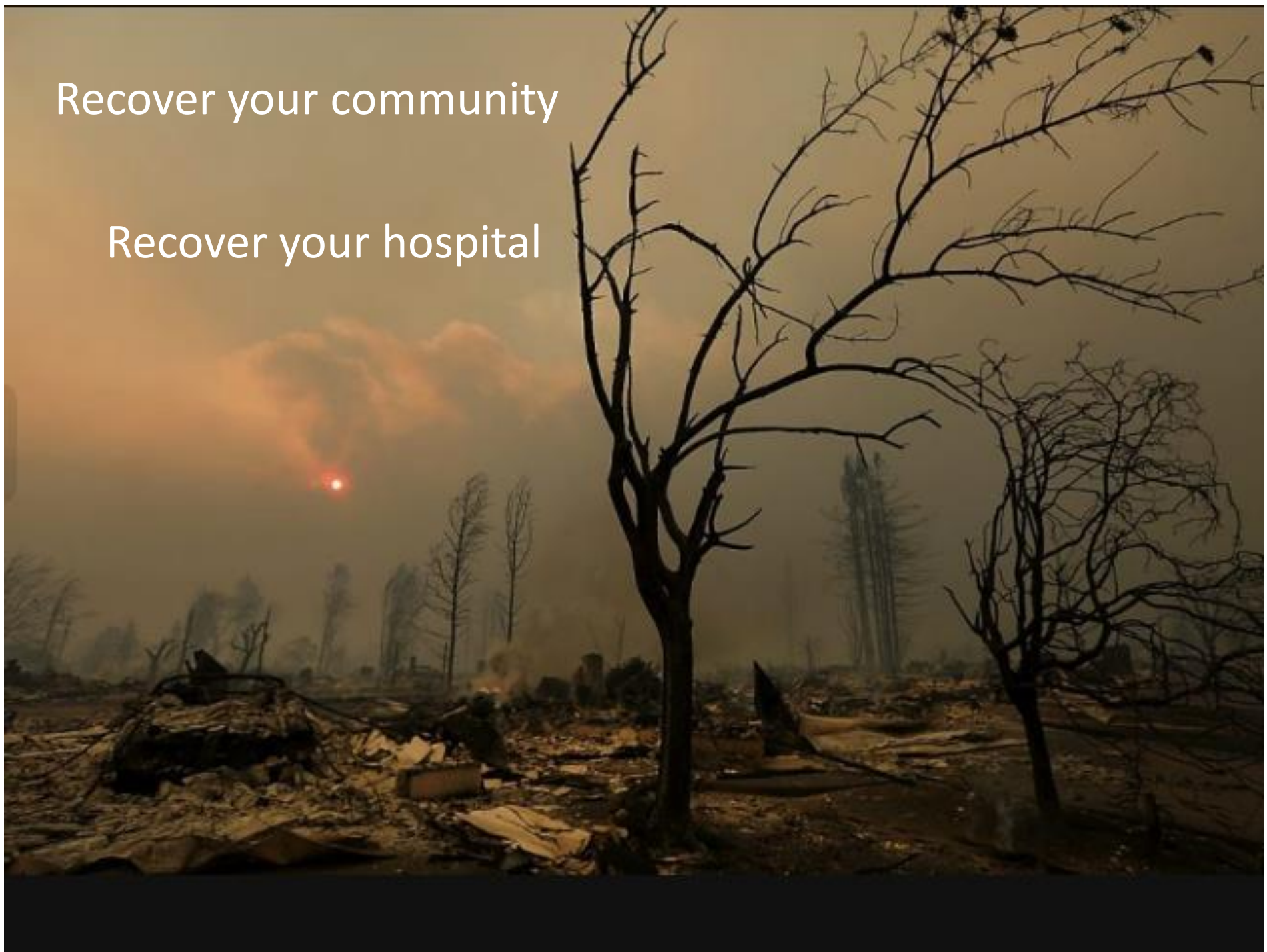
